The Baptist Student Center (BSC) is an independent, faith-based nonprofit that serves the university community of Southeast Missouri State in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. Southeast Missouri State is a regional university of about 10,000. The university has many international students. Cape Girardeau is the largest town on the Mississippi River between Saint Louis and Memphis and is a regional hub. The BSC was originally founded in 1939 and has a historic building located strategically near the center of campus. Dr. Bruce Gentry is starting his nineteenth year as director. Baptist Student Center Resident Administrator

The Resident Administrator functions as the office and building manager of the BSC. This position facilitates smooth and efficient function of the Baptist Student Center office and building facilities, through part-time office hours and an assumed 8-10 hours of miscellaneous management tasks and building coordination. This role will serve as the first point of contact regarding all building functions and issues, ensuring that necessary action is taken either by the Resident Administrator or by coordinating with another party.

Time Expectation: .75 Full Time Equivalent, 2 days of in-office hours and on call, live-in responsibilities as needed.

Compensation:

- Baptist Student Center apartment + utilities
- Starting salary of \$21,000 and possibly higher with experience and/or expertise
- Health insurance stipend (depending on candidate unique situation)
