Admissions and English Proficiency

Start your application today. Chin and Kachin cohorts will begin in Fall (August) 2026 and Fall 2028. Official transcripts, character references and an autobiographical statement will be required for admission. Applicants should have a bachelor's degree from an accredited educational institution. A limited number of students without an earned baccalaureate degree or its equivalent may be admitted to the MA program through alternative credentialing. Applicants for whom English is not their first language will be required to demonstrate their English proficiency through a writing sample or interview.
